The United Bowhunters of Pennsylvania's Disabled Hunter Program began in 1999. The idea of the program was presented to the UBP leadership and gained approval to move forward. The program was encouraged by David Sullivan of Buckmasters Disabled

Hunter Services. They agreed to supply a hunt if the UBP could come up with the funds for the transportation to the hunt. The Physically Challenged Bowhunters of America (PCBA) and Buckmasters supplied the applications that first year. Each year the program grew a little and before long, a dedicated committee was formed. The program currently sends at least four disabled hunters on hunts each year. The program is funded primarily from the proceeds from our yearly fund raising banquet. The Disabled Hunters Program is non-profit. The banquet has become one of the premiere sportsmen events in the area, typically selling out each year at around 300 attendees.

Help disabled hunters from Pennsylvania experience the thrill of hunting.
